**ORDER GRANTING JOINT ORAL MOTION TO UNSEAL DOCUMENTS**

---

This Cause was before the Court for a telephonic status conference on July 19, 2018. (ECF No. 104.) At the conference, the parties orally moved to unseal, with certain redactions to protect personal identifying information of individuals, documents filed as a matter of record in support of and in opposition to pending Motions for Summary Judgment as well as a presently pending *in camera* review of materials pertaining to the defendant's objections to the production of documents pertaining to the existence and use of a confidential source on issues relevant to this litigation.

In this Joint Oral Motion to Unseal Documents, the defendant has elected to withdraw all pending requests to maintain the sealed status of the documents referenced in the Motion and in this Order, including the documents filed and presently pending before the Court for *in camera* review. Plaintiff has no objection to the withdrawal of those designations, with the exception of certain redactions in documents that will be filed unsealed to protect the personal identifying information of individuals in accordance with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 5.2.

The parties' Joint Oral Motion is GRANTED. All pending motions raising issues concerning the propriety of keeping documents filed under seal or submitted for *in camera* review are now moot. The Court further finds that it is appropriate to modify the Court's July 16, 2018 Order denying the defendant's motion to hold in abeyance the unsealing of certain documents pending resolution of the defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment on the Issue of Standing. That Order is now modified so that the parties are directed to refile, on or before **July 24, 2018**, unsealed Motions for Summary Judgment and supporting documents presently a part of the record under seal, with the exception of documents containing personal identifying information of individuals under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 5.2, which will be filed in redacted form. The parties will file unsealed Responses to Motions for Summary Judgment and supporting documents on or before 3:00 p.m. on **July 25, 2018**, and Replies to these Motions with supporting documents between 3:00 p.m. and midnight on **July 25, 2018**.
