**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT’S MOTION TO PARTIALLY WITHDRAW ITS
MOTION TO MODIFY OR VACATE THE KENDRICK CONSENT DECREE**

Before the Court is the City of Memphis’s June 11, 2020 Motion to Partially Withdraw its Motion for Relief from Judgment or Order. (ECF No. 332.) The City moves the Court to partially withdraw its August 15, 2018 Motion for Relief from Judgment or Order (ECF No. 124), which sought to modify or vacate the Kendrick Consent Decree. (ECF No. 332.) The City asserts that it no longer seeks to vacate the Decree and only seeks modification of the Decree. (Id. at PageID 10207.) The Court **GRANTS** the City’s Motion to Withdraw. The City’s Motion for Modification is limited to the issues raised by the City at the June 8, 2020 Pre-Hearing Conference and the June 17, 2020 Modification Hearing.
