ORDER SETTING HEARING

Before the Court is the City of Memphis’s Motion to Set a Hearing Date filed on March 2, 2020. (ECF No. 289.) The City moves the Court for a hearing following the Independent Monitor’s submission of a letter to the Court on Friday, February 28, 2020 detailing the City’s alleged noncompliance with Sanction 5 of the Court’s Order Memorializing Sanctions (ECF No. 152). (Id.) The Independent Monitor’s letter also requests a hearing before the Court to discuss the City’s noncompliance with Sanction 5. The Court GRANTS the Motion.
