**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT’S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF DEADLINE TO
FILE QUARTERLY SEARCH TERMS**

Before the Court is Defendant City of Memphis’s October 15, 2019 Motion for Extension of Deadline to File Quarterly Search Terms. (ECF No. 234.) Defendant moves the Court “for a brief extension of time to file this Quarter’s ‘list of all search terms entered into social media collators or otherwise used by MPD officers collecting information on social media while on duty,’” requesting a new deadline of October 22, 2019. (Id. at PageID 8005.) Defendant contends, “Because this Quarter’s reporting deadline falls during the week of the local school systems’ Fall Break when many officers are on vacation, the City requests a modest extension of one week to that deadline so that it may be sure to collect a complete inventory of search terms used by all relevant MPD officers.” (Id.) Defendant’s Motion is well taken and **GRANTED**. Defendant shall submit this Quarter’s complete list of all search terms used by Memphis Police Department officers no later than October 22, 2019.
