7 litigation?

9 Q. And I'll represent to you that I have seen
10 chapter minutes from the West Tennessee chapter of the
11 ACLU of Tennessee which referenced the Kendrick decree
12 in one manner or another in the 1977-'76 time frame,
13 my question to you is -- unless you can tell me where
14 to find it -- I haven't seen where there was a formal
15 resolution of any kind from the ACLU of Tennessee,
16 Inc., approving or endorsing that litigation from the
17 standpoint of the ACLU of Tennessee, Inc., is there
18 such a formal endorsement or approval of the Kendrick
19 litigation that you're aware of from the ACLU of
20 Tennessee, Inc.?

21 A. I don't know. But I don't know that it would
22 have happened either formally or been stated on paper.
