**ORDER GRANTING THE CITY’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE QUARTERLY SUBMISSION OF SEARCH TERMS**

Before the Court is Defendant City of Memphis’s Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Quarterly Submission of Search Terms, filed on April 14, 2021. (ECF No. 398.)
