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**ORDER GRANTING THE CITY’S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE AND/OR  
A STAY OF FILING QUARTERLY SUBMISSION OF SEARCH TERMS IN LIGHT OF  
RECENT CYBERSECURITY ISSUES**

Before the Court is Defendant City of Memphis’s (“City”) Unopposed Motion for Continuance and/or a Stay of Filing Quarterly Submission of Search Terms in Light of Recent Cybersecurity Issues, filed on January 13, 2021. (ECF No. 391.) The City moves the Court for a continuance and/or a stay of the filing of its quarterly search term submissions pursuant to Sanction 5 of the Court’s Opinion and Order (ECF No. 151 at PageID 6275), until the Court issues a standing Order on the procedure for filing documents under seal or otherwise provides specific guidance related to the City’s sealed search terms submissions. (ECF No. 391 at PageID 13875.) For good cause shown, the City’s Motion is **GRANTED**. The City shall file this quarter’s search terms **within 14 days** of the entry of a standing Order on the procedure for filing Highly Sensitive Documents (HSDs).
